DONATE THE SMART WAY – STRAIGHT FROM YOUR PAY!

It's a great feeling when you accomplish something big at work. And it's a great feeling when you do something that helps make the world a better place. Now's your chance to do both at once. By joining your Workplace Giving program and making regular gifts from your salary to RSPCA WA, you'll be helping animals in need throughout Western Australia.

What is Workplace Giving?

Workplace Giving (or Payroll Giving) is a way to donate to RSPCA WA directly from your pay, before tax is calculated.

To make a payroll donation, complete the payroll deduction form on the next page and deliver it to your payroll officer.

If your organisation doesn't offer a Workplace Giving program, please talk to your management or payroll department about setting one up so that you, and your colleagues, can help fight animal cruelty.

This is why donations through Workplace Giving play such a vital part in our annual fundraising.

Even a small regular contribution can make a significant difference to animals in need.

If you care about the welfare of animals in your local community, there really is no simpler way to make a difference to animals in need.

Benefits for You

When you make a Workplace Giving donation, **you receive the tax benefit of your donation immediately** – it is deducted from your pre-tax income, so you pay less tax.

At the end of the financial year, **your employer will include the total amount you donated to charities in your payment summary**, letter or email.

You don't have to worry about direct debits or credit card payments.

Benefits for Animals in Need

Workplace Giving results in **regular, reliable income for the RSPCA** and makes a real and lasting impact to the animals in our care, ensuring **we can continue to rescue, rehabilitate and rehome animals suffering from cruelty and neglect**, and deliver vital services to the community.

RSPCA WA **relies on generous donations and community support for around 90%** of what it costs to carry out our animal protection work.

It's as easy as 1-2-3

1. Ask your employer to enter into a Workplace Giving arrangement.
2. Nominate RSPCA WA as your preferred charity
3. Inform your employer that you wish to make a regular donation (for example fortnightly, monthly or whenever you are paid) and the amount you wish to donate. They will pay it directly to RSPCA WA on your behalf.
